



## ANNOUNCEMENT

**PCVC** is aware that financial issues for many may cause a concern to families when considering participation in JO. We believe all children should have access to sports regardless of a family's financial situation. For this reason, **PCVC** has adopted a Scholarship Program for qualified families participating at **PCVC**.

The purpose of PCVC's sports scholarship for children is simply to allow the recipients to participate in PCVC's JO activities that might not be able to for economic reasons. PCVC will provide a limited number of partial registration fee scholarships, ranging from 25% to 75% of the club registration fee. Approximately \$3,000.00 in scholarship funds are available for 2013-2014 JO season.

Here's how it works:

- Contact the Club Director for guidelines and application
- Submit the application
- A review board will evaluate the application
- All applications are kept private and confidential

**The scholarship process and the tryout process are separate.** Submitting an application does not guarantee a roster spot. A roster offer does not guarantee a scholarship. PCVC coaches selecting players for their teams will not know about scholarship applications. If an approved scholarship applicant is awarded a roster spot and you accept, the scholarship will be applied to PCVC club fees.

This is the first year of the scholarship program and we are fine tuning the process. We are working out the details to establish a scholarship program we hope will be around for many years. The program has been funded by a private anonymous donor.

It has long been my heartfelt goal to ease financial hardships on families that participate In JO or whose daughter might not otherwise be able to play JO volleyball. I am glad to make this program available to those families that may need it.
