

Through a donation from anonymous donor, PCVC is able to provide partial registration fee Scholarships (between 25% and 75% of registration fee) to children who, without this financial assistance, would not be able to or it would create a hardship for the family to participate in JO at PCVC. This scholarship program focuses on providing opportunities for youth to participate in JO because of the physical, mental, and character building benefits this programs provide. For the upcoming JO season, approximately \$3,000.00 in funds have been made available to distribute.

Scholarships are limited to two awards per family, or members of the same address, per year, provided that funds are available. Not all scholarship applications will be funded. Incomplete applications will be rejected. Misleading application information, or expulsion from a program, will result in placement on scholarship probation for a period of one year following the end date of the current JO season.

All scholarships will be awarded based on demonstrated need, available funding, and meeting deadline/application requirements.

Requirements for eligibility:

- Receive an offer to play on a PCVC team.
- Have a Parent or Legal Guardian complete all required paperwork.
- Include with the application a minimum 100 word essay from the child describing why they like volleyball and what benefits they feel they get from playing volleyball.

Not a requirement but a request:

- Children must commit to (3) three hours of community service back to their community Recreation, Parks or Arts programs. Contact your communities Rec department, please.

Families applying for assistance must:

- Mail application to the address listed on the bottom of this notice;
- Include with application proof of current income for all household members. Examples Include:
 - 1 Month of current consecutive pay stubs – or –
 - Most recent completed tax return

Priority will be given to eligible youth meeting one or more of the criteria below:

- Member of a multi-child family.
- Living in a single parent home.
- Meets financial guidelines listed in the chart below.
